Sub: Science City, Department of Higher Education, Government of Tamilnadu - Seminar on "Nanoscience and Nanotechnology for Global Well-being" for B.Sc., Final year & M.Sc., First Year students - 3rd to 6th October, 2023 - Registration Open - Intimated - Reg.

As your may be aware the Department of Science and Technology, have notified the theme for National Science Day 2023 as "Global Science for Global Wellbeing". The theme highlights India's expanding worldwide influence and rising international prominence. The theme has been chosen to raise public appreciation of scientific issues in a global context which is having a bearing on global well-being. When discussing the role that nanotechnology might play in global health, the benefits that nano-enabled strategies could afford in terms of improving environment, energy and global healthcare. To create awareness on the global issues and the impact of Nanotechnology, it is essential to educate the students and public on the fundamental and application of Science at Nanoscale and its impact on the technology.

In line with the theme announced by the Department of Science and Technology, Science City, Department of Higher Education, Government of Tamilnadu will be organising a 4 day seminar on "Nanoscience and Nanotechnology for Global Well-being" for B.Sc., final year and M.Sc., first year students for Four days from 3rd to 6th October, 2023. The seminar will cover the following broad areas of nanoscience and nanotechnology:

1. Role of Nanoscale in Science of Materials
2. Fabrication of Nanoscale materials
3. Energy Nanomaterials and its role in Electrical Mobility
4. Environmental care with Nanotechnology
5. Bio Nanomaterials for Healthcare

A total of 125 students will be enrolled for the programme and a maximum of 10 students from each college will be enrolled. The workshop timing will be from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.

Registration for the workshop is now open and there is no Registration Fee. Interested institutions may send the list of students based on their academic credentials and interest in Nanoscience and Nanotechnology to attend the seminar before 3.00 p.m., on 26th September, 2023.
